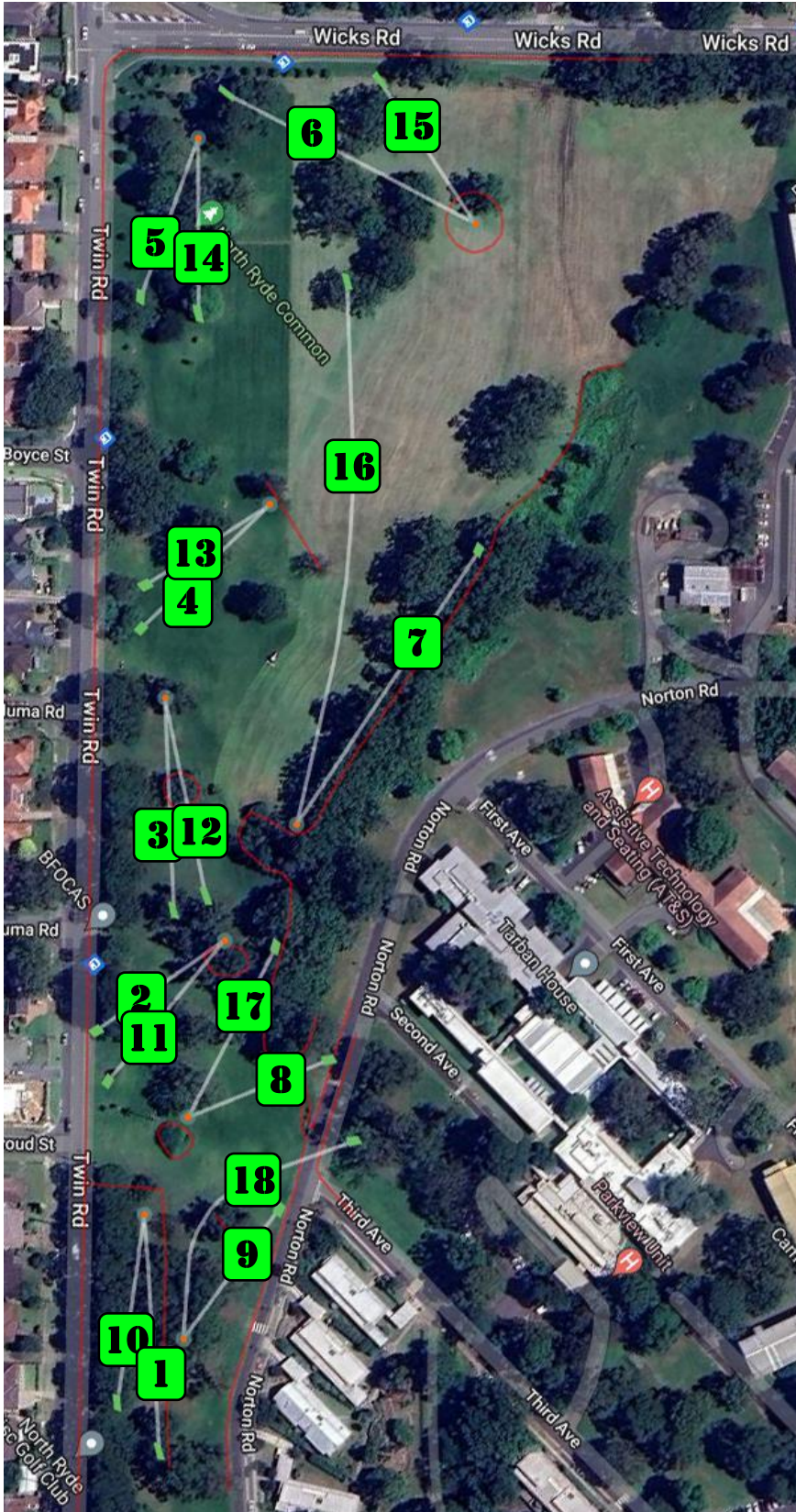

**Hole 1**

**Par 3**

**89 m**



The standard starting hole at North Ryde and longest part 3 of the event. Wide open fairway.

**OB** – Road on left side. Painted line between the trees on the right and behind the basket.

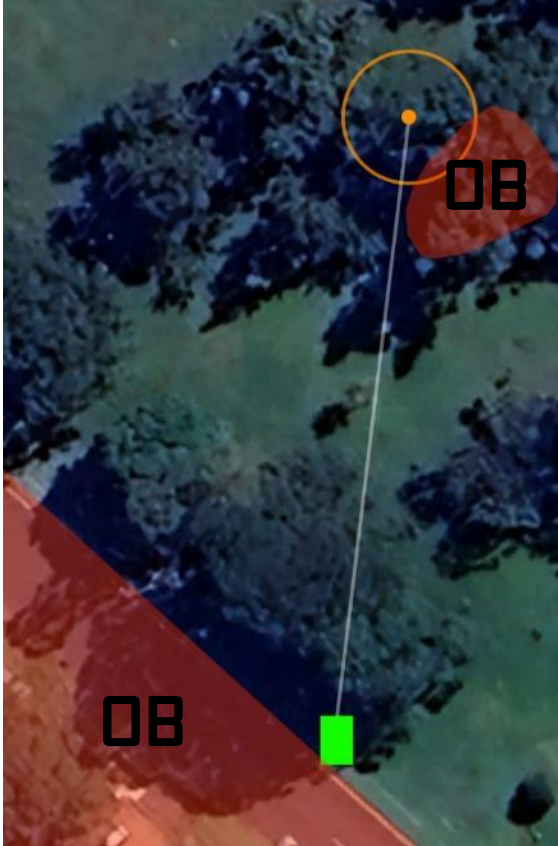

**59 m**



A short downhill shot between the 2 gums. Avoid the shrub in the middle of the fairway.

**OB** – Road behind the tee and the garden bed right of the basket.

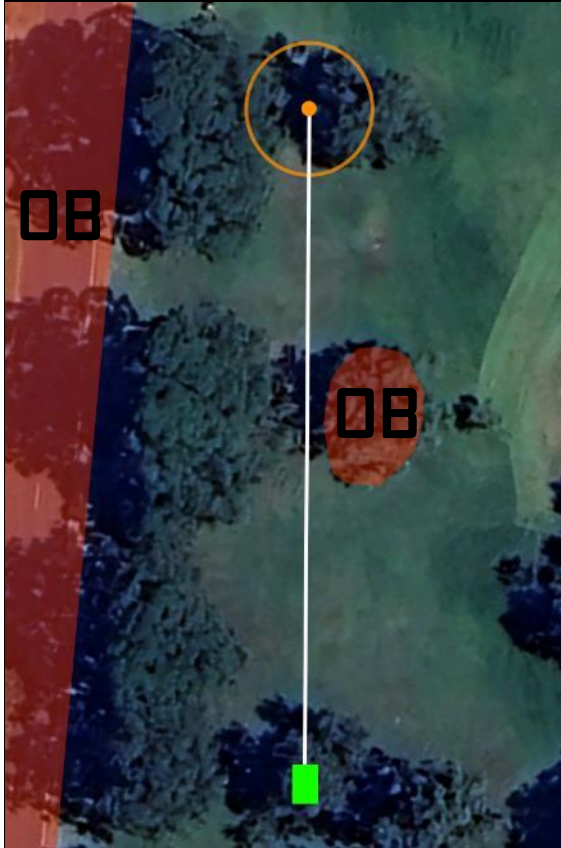

The typical hole 3. Beware the trees down the right and a few small trees in the middle of the fairway.

**OB** – Road on the left side and garden bed on the right and half way to the basket.

A different take on the typical hole 13.

**MANDO** – Do not pass between the trees. Pick a side and go either left or right. Miss the mando and proceed to the drop zone between the trees.

**OB** – Road behind the basket.

The typical hole 5. Uphill shot with a low ceiling.

**OB** – Road on left and top of the hill

A short par 4 with a low ceiling a plenty of guardians protecting the basket. Does anybody have the power to shoot for the eagle?

**OB** – Road on left side.

**Hole 7**

**Par 4**

**123 m**



The regular hole 7. Bail out between the trees on the right side for the safe play or take the riskier straight shot

**OB** – Painted line down left side and behind the basket

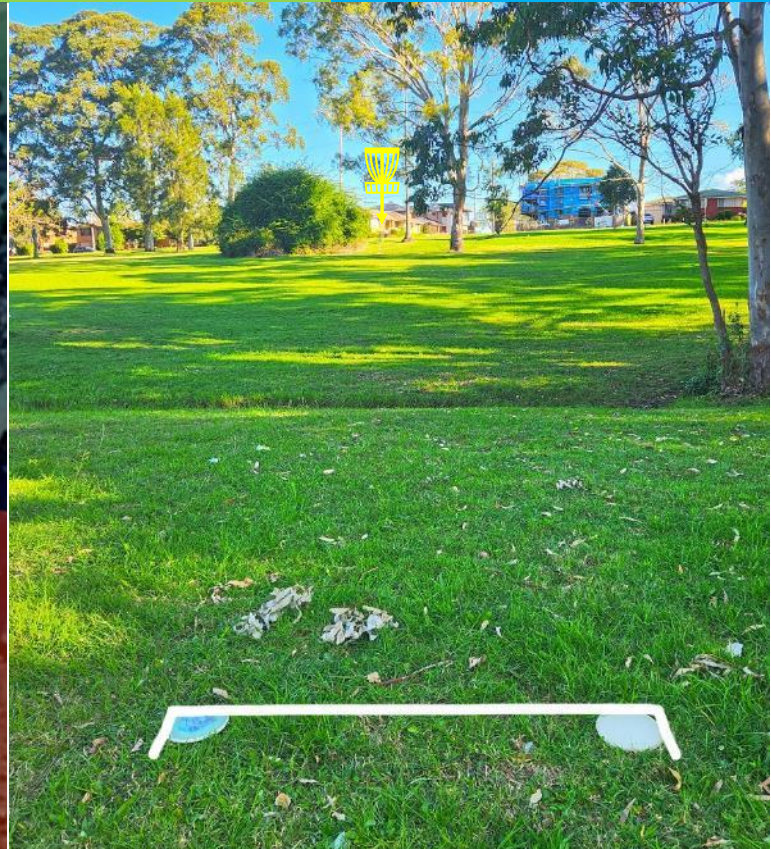

**Hole 8**

**Par 3**

**57 m**



Short uphill shot taking care not to hit the low branches above the drain.

**OB** - The road behind and to the left of the tee, the drain and bushy area just in front of the tee (painted line) and the large bush behind the basket.

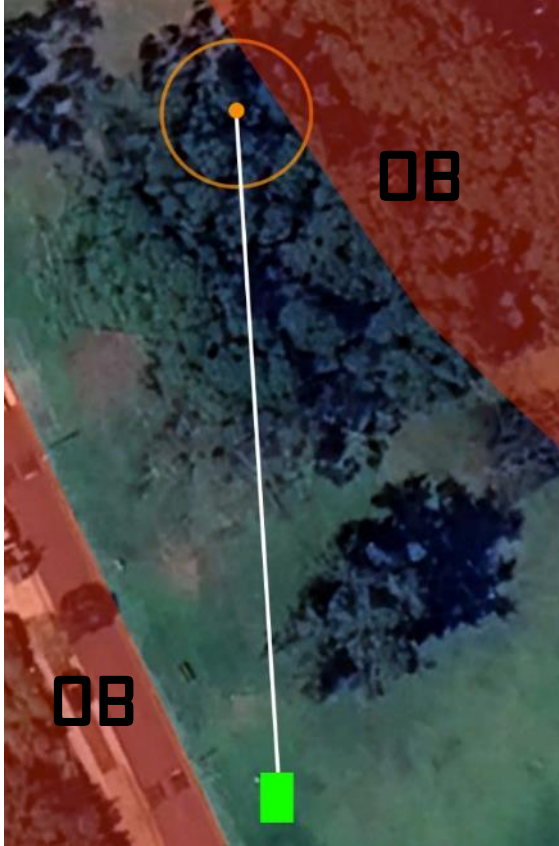

**60 m**



The usual hole 9 with a few trees to navigate around.

**OB** – Road on left and painted line between the trees on the right and behind the basket.

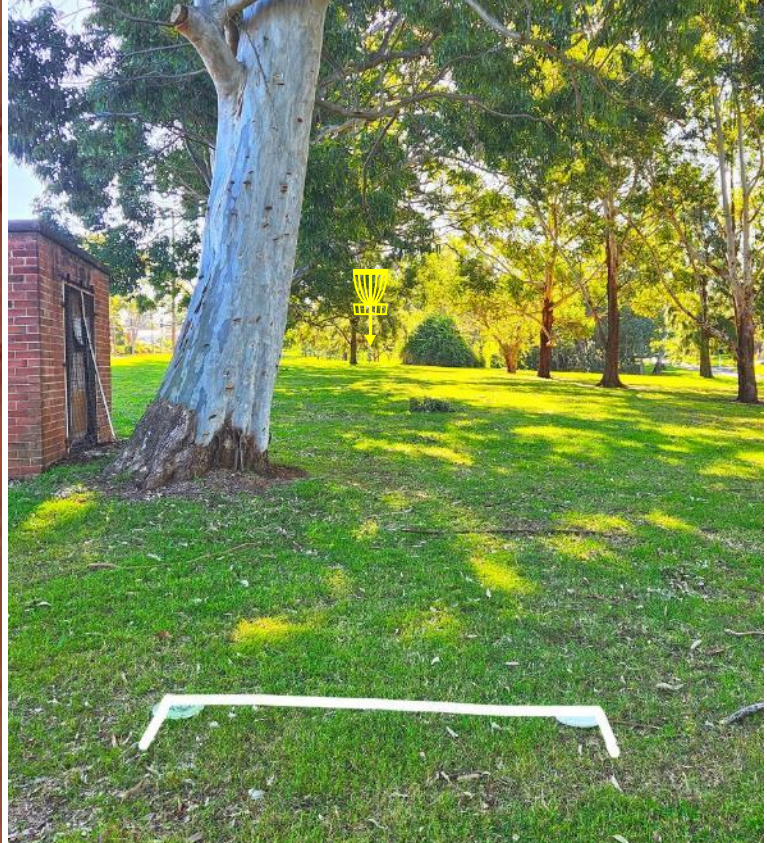
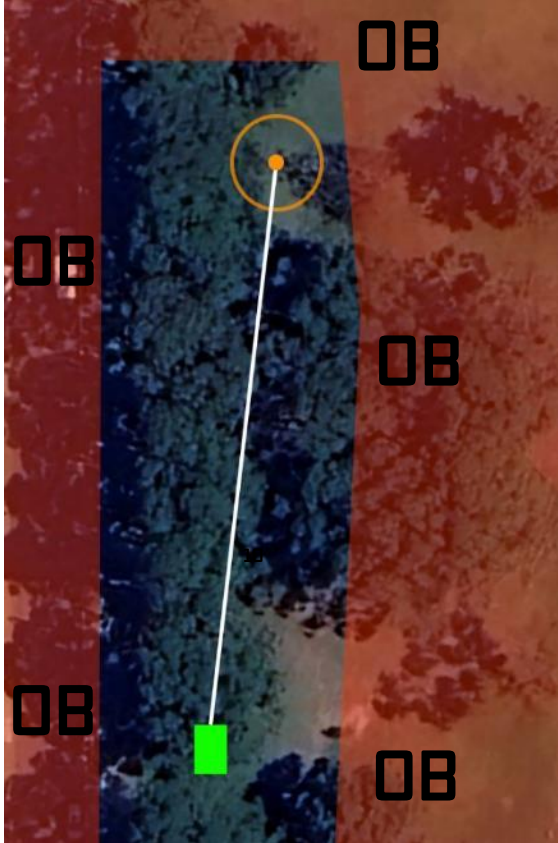

**71 m**



Low ceiling shot down a relatively open fairway.

**OB** – Road on left side. Painted line between the trees on the right and behind the basket.

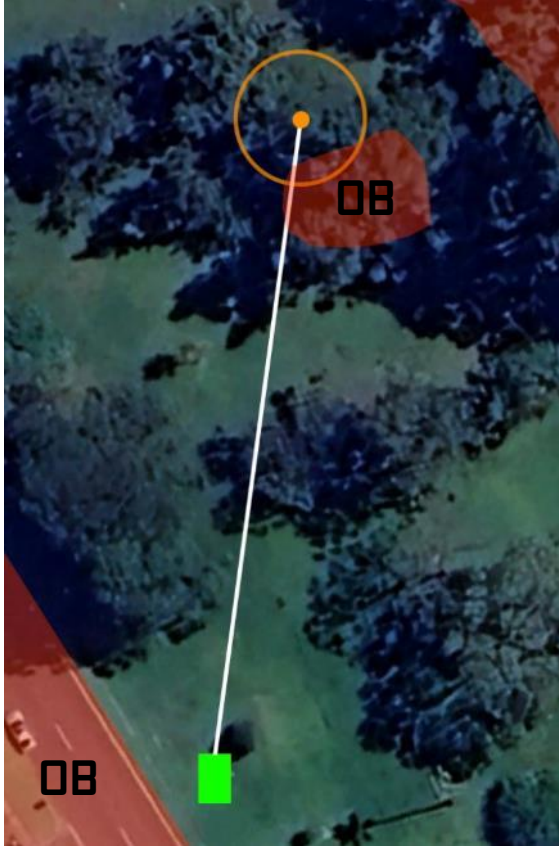

The usual hole 2.

**OB** – Road on left and garden bed short right of the basket.

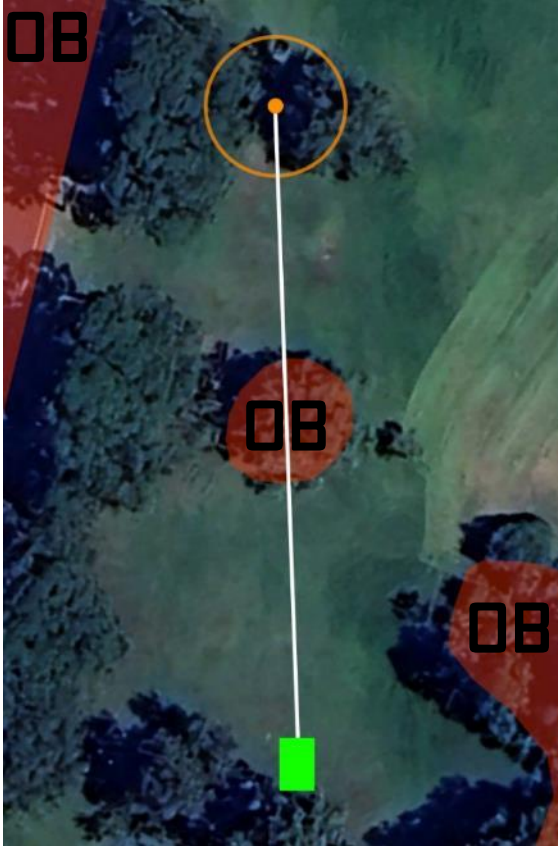

**76 m**



Choose your line. You'll need to shape a short either left or right side of the OB garden bed.

**OB** – Road on the far left and garden bed midway between the tee and basket.

**56 m**



The usual hole 4 through the double mando.

**DOUBLE MANDO** – must pass between the 2 gum trees. Miss the mando and proceed to the drop zone between the trees.

**OB** – Road behind the tee.

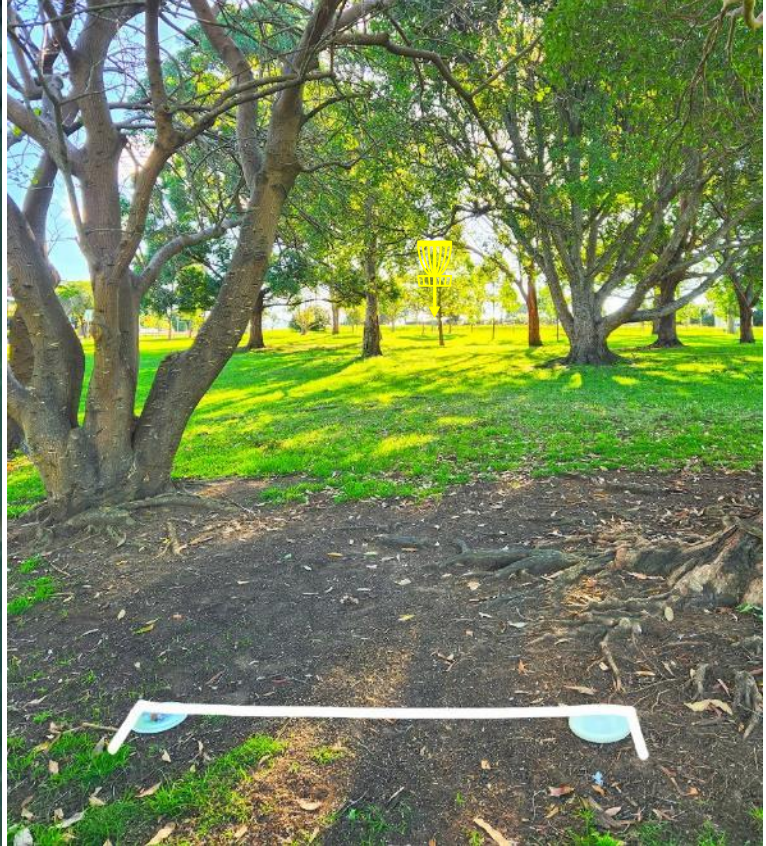

**66 m**



Low ceiling shot uphill between the trees.

**OB** – Road to the far left.

**Hole 15**

**Par 3**

**64 m**



The usual hole 6 but with the island enlarged to 12 metres.

**OB** - everywhere is OB except for the island surrounding the basket.  
All OB shots from the tee proceed to the drop zone next to the tree.  
Normal OB rules apply for all subsequent shots.

**Hole 16**

**Par 5**

**206 m**



A downhill par 5 to a basket with OB nearby.

**MANDO** – must pass to the left of the dead tree midway between the tee and basket.

**OB** – down the left side marked by a painted line and behind the basket.

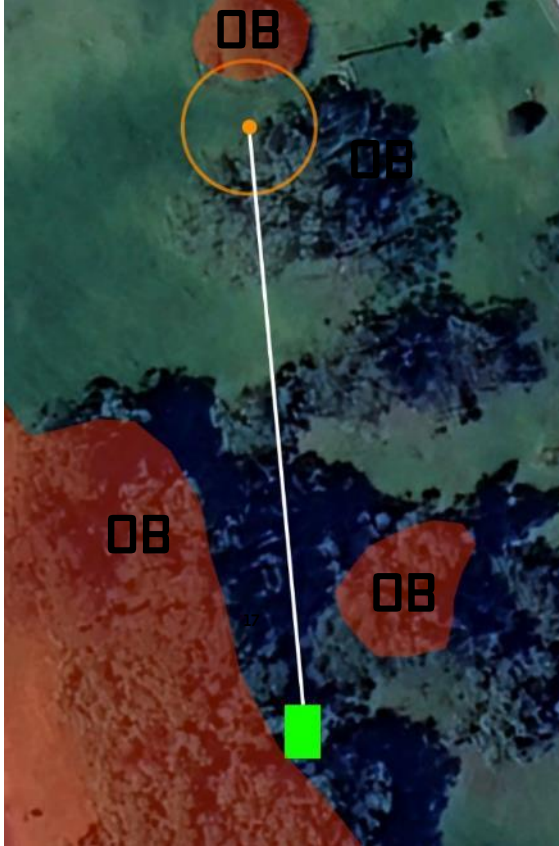

**Hole 17**

**Par 3**

**72 m**



The usual hole 8, uphill drive between the tall gums.

**OB** – Garden beds behind the tee and on the right side, plus the large bush behind the basket.

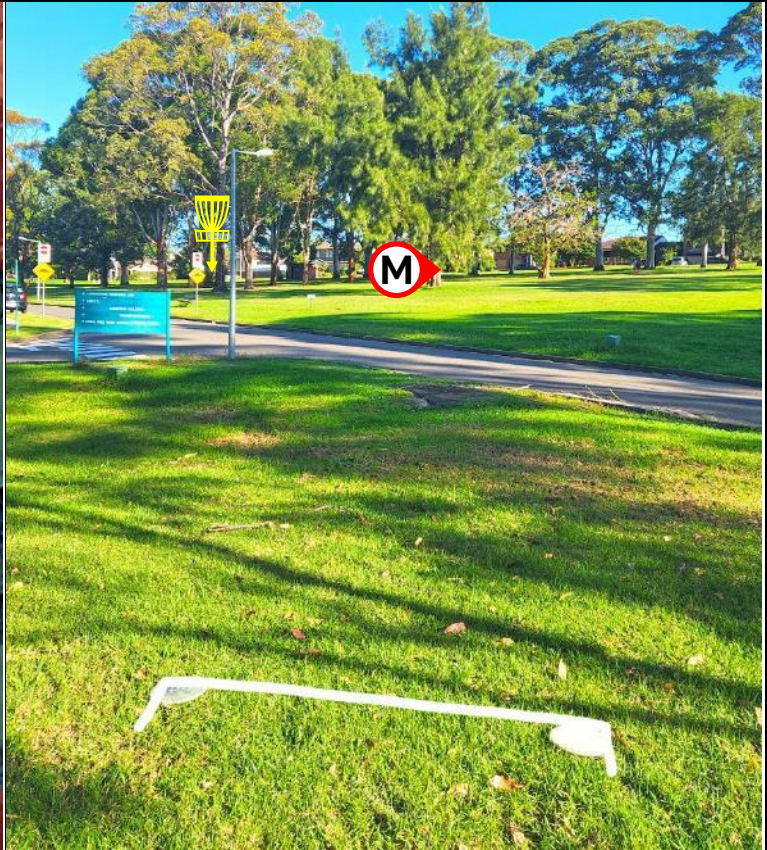
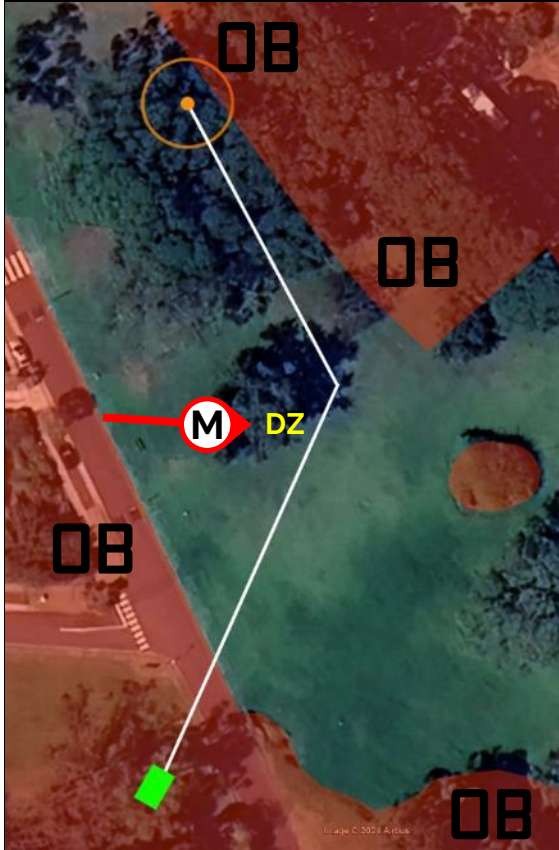

**Hole 18**

**Par 4**

**117 m**



Teeing off from across the road. Plan your tee shot carefully so you can attack the basket on your second shot.

**MANDO** – Must pass to the right of the mando tree. Proceed to the drop zone to the right of the tree if mando missed.

**OB** – Teeing from OB area so must cross the road (re-tee with penalty if you do not cross in-bounds). Large bush on right and painted line between the trees on right side.

## OUT OF BOUNDS

Refer to hole notes. If not otherwise stated, normal OB rules apply.

The edges of all roads denote out-of-bounds. You must be touching grass to be in-bounds. All other out-of-bounds marked by white painted line.
